October—Implement Fundraising (best methods); Brainstorm Summer Adventure possibilities

November—Plan Christmas parties; Share winter camping ideas

**December**—Share importance and reasoning of ALL IN Ribbon Award; Plan for next month's March for Life and January Service project ideas for your Charter Organizations

**March**—Spring Camporee details; Promote participation in National Day of Prayer (1<sup>st</sup> Thursday in May); Advancement and Courts of Honor

**April**—How to assess current Troop status (utilize <u>Trail Tracks</u>); Planning your upcoming program year (<u>Understanding the Program Year</u>, <u>Annual Program Planning and Budgeting</u>); Integrating Faith and Spiritual Development, Religious Awards
